

Awareness Programme Fish Health Management organized in Champawat

ICAR-DCFR Field Centre, Champawat organized one day **Awareness Programme** on fish health management for the fish farmers of the district Champawat at Pati block on 12th January, 2016 under the National Surveillance programme for Aquatic Animal Diseases. A total of 79 farmers belonging to 15 villages of Champawat attended the programme. The programme was aimed to build up awareness among fish farmers towards better aquaculture management practices for prevention and control of fish diseases. Participating farmers were educated about the management of water quality of the ponds and harmful effects of banned chemicals and medicines unknowingly used by fish farmers for controlling diseases. Shri Pitamber Gahotori and Shri Krishnand Gahotori, progressive farmers shared their experience with fish farmers. Scientists such as Dr Suresh Chandra, Shri S. K. Mallik and Shri R.S. Tendal coordinated the programme. Feedbacks from the participants were also received in order to improve future programmes in this line.
